Motorised Vehicle Policy

The purpose of this policy is to set out the criteria under which students may bring motorised vehicles on to the academy site. The policy in intended to supplement the Academy's Health and Safety Policy and to ensure safe use of the site for all users.

- No student shall bring onto the academy site any motorised transport such as Motorised Mini Scooters, Segway and/or Balance Boards
- Students in Year 7 11 may not come onto the School site using any other form of motorised vehicle such as a moped
- Students in the sixth form may come onto the site using motorised vehicles provide that:
 - they have provided documentary evidence of their entitlement to drive/ride the vehicle by reference to their driving licence, the vehicle's MOT certificate & their Certificate of Insurance and that they have signed a form to confirm that they will comply with the regulations laid down by the Head of Sixth Form (Appendix 1)
 - they use the vehicles appropriately and do not breach any of the academy's general Health and Safety Guidelines
 - there is sufficient space to park on the campus
