

Attitude to Learning Statements

1	Outstanding	<p>Students with an outstanding attitude to learning are real <u>role models for other students</u>. They:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are eager to learn and take full responsibility for their own learning • Behave independently in a way which consistently helps themselves and others to learn • Have exemplary attendance and punctuality
2	Good	<p>Students with a good attitude to learning <u>work hard and are positive about their learning</u>. They:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Behave in a way which consistently helps themselves and others to learn • Respond immediately to instructions and do not disrupt lessons • Have above average attendance and excellent punctuality
3	Need for Improvement	<p>Students who need to improve their attitude to learning are <u>coasting and should aim even higher to fulfil their potential</u>. They:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Require reminders and sanctions to remain focussed on their learning • Do not always respond to instructions • Need to improve their attendance and punctuality
4	Serious Concerns	<p>Students whose attitude to learning is causing serious concern <u>neglect their school work and are falling behind</u>. They:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regularly behave in a way which prevents themselves and others from learning • Often do not respond to instructions • Have attendance/ punctuality which is a serious concern

Special consideration will be given to those students whose attendance is below the expected standard due to exceptional circumstances.
