2	Good	 Students with a good attitude to learning work hard and are positive about their learning. They: Behave in a way which consistently helps themselves and others to learn Respond immediately to instructions and do not disrupt lessons Have above average attendance and excellent punctuality
3	Need for Improvement	 Students who need to improve their attitude to learning are <u>coasting</u> <u>and should aim even higher to fulfil their potential</u>. They: Require reminders and sanctions to remain focussed on their learning Do not always respond to instructions Need to improve their attendance and punctuality
4	Serious Concerns	 Students whose attitude to learning is causing serious concern <u>neglect</u> their school work and are falling behind. They: Regularly behave in a way which prevents themselves and others from learning Often do not respond to instructions Have attendance/ punctuality which is a serious concern
