Impact of Absence

- Any absence affects a child's education.
- Regular patterns of absence seriously affect learning.
- Catching up on missed work is difficult and places great stress on the child.
- Good attendance means the child is learning and is being kept safe.



ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS

- 190 school days in an academic year
- We aim for all our students to have 97 % attendance

PERSISTENTLY ABSENT STUDENTS

- A student that is persistently absent in one academic year is at high risk of being persistently absent for their school life.
- A student that has attendance at 90% throughout years 7-11 will miss 475 hours of learning.
- A student that is at 90% is likely to achieve a grade lower than they are capable of.



WHY 97%?

- Every lesson counts students have not been allowed in school for a significant amount of time. At Wreake Valley Academy we say that every lesson counts. All staff have this as their primary objective.
- Good behaviour- Good attendance allows student to establish good behaviour patterns.
- Social Skills Maintains good social interactions and interactions with friendship groups.
- Positive future A greater chance of success in later life.



CLARIFICATION POINTS

- The law states parents have a legal duty to ensure their children have access to full time education.
- As a school we will make absent day calls for students that are not in school.
- Where possible please provide evidence for the reasons for your child's absence.
- We cannot authorise family holidays or family visits.
- We will consider day release for students that participate in national organisations or equivalent organisations.
- If your child has cold symptoms you can still send them into school.
- If your child has Covid- 19 symptoms you should not send them in and follow our guidance.



SUPPORTING YOUR FAMILY

- Attendance is a joint effort. Looking at patterns and reasons for absence can be clues to something that is worrying your child. If this is the case we encourage you to contact your child's tutor and discuss your concerns. Miss Price will also support with any concerns that you may have.
- A student that is happy, confident and enjoys their learning will have good attendance. We will support you as a family to ensure that happens.



EXPECTATIONS

- 4. Outcomes




POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

	In class behaviour management		
Remind C1	Behaviour for Learning below expectations.	Student encouraged to reset behaviour. Possible informal sanction given by the teacher.	Teacher
Move C2	Continuous poor behaviour. Homework not handed in. Late arrival.	Student moved to another seat in the class. 10 minute detention issued.	Teacher
Remove C3	Persistent poor behaviour after C1 and C2 issued.	Subject teacher to make a phone call home. 30 minute SLT detention issued.	Teacher /HoD
