---

- **A job for people ages 16+ with a training programme attended by the apprentice in an educational establishment.**
- **A paid contract of employment with a company.**



# Different levels of apprenticeships

---

**When looking for an apprenticeship, it is important to look at the different levels of apprenticeships and their entry requirements to understand which level of apprenticeship you should be applying for. Apprenticeship frameworks are all different so ensure you do your research-if you are uncertain seek guidance.**



# Different levels of apprenticeships

<u>Apprenticeship levels:</u>	<u>Equivalent to:</u>
Intermediate level 2	GCSEs ( you usually start here depending on the industry and the skills required.)
Advanced level 3	A levels
Higher Level	Certificate of Higher
