Dear Parents & Carers

RE: Uniform from August 2022 onwards

You may recall that we held a consultation process on the school uniform for Wreake Valley Academy and The Roundhill Academy towards the end of the last academic year. Since then, we have been in negotiations with various uniform suppliers to secure the best possible price and quality items for parents. The current uniform Supplier for The Roundhill Academy; Price and Buckland have been chosen to be the supplier for both secondary schools.

The school uniform for Wreake Valley remains the same. There are some changes to the PE Kit from August 2022, which we will be phasing in over the coming years. Students will continue to come to school in their PE kit on the days they have PE. The new PE kit will be compulsory for Year 7 students and optional for Years 8 -11 for the next academic year as we phase the new PE kit in across the school.

Students in years 8 -11 can continue to wear the navy and sky blue PE t-shirts if they wish to or they can choose to wear the new black PE t-shirt. All students in all year groups must wear plain black bottoms without any logos – this can be all black shorts, all black leggings or all black joggers. If students choose to wear additional layers for warmth this must be one of the optional items; either the school hoodie or midlayer.

School uniform will be available to order online from our new uniform supplier

Price & Buckland. The uniform can be ordered online for home delivery for a small charge.

Alternatively, you can choose to order online and collect from the school on a nominated date, free of charge. Returns are free, instructions are provided with your order. Blazers and ties are also available from Uniform Direct and Schoolwear solutions, details can be found on our website.

Price & Buckland will be providing parents with a size guide to make ordering simpler, we will write to you with this after Easter.

Orders can be placed online with Price & Buckland from the end of April for delivery from July onwards.

Parents may also want to take advantage of our Uniform Swap and Sale shop. Parents who join the online Facebook group are able to swap, sell and request items of uniform. Some items are given away for free whilst for others there is a small cost. To join the group click the link below and request to join:

Blazer	Navy school blazer with school logo		
Shirt	Plain white school style shirt, buttoned through to the collar. Plain white T-shirt may be worn under the shirt		
Tie	School tie with a neat knot with 5 stripes showing below the knot		
Skirt	Mid grey plain school skirt. Length no shorter than just above the knee. The skirt should not be tightly tailored or of a stretchy "lycra" type material. It must not be split above the knee.		
Trousers	Mid grey plain school style trousers Tight fitting or cropped trousers are not acceptable. No stretch fabrics, jean style or turn ups.		
Shorts	Tailored shorts, mid grey plain school style		
Jumper - optional	Plain grey v-neck school jumper		
Tights	Black, navy, grey or neutral		
Footwear		All black, plain polishable flat footwear	
	No sandals or open toe footwear of any description
