<b>Summary of provision</b>	<p>The Bradgate Inclusion Centre is an Enhanced Resource Base for students with communication and interaction difficulties, anxiety and sensory differences, usually associated with ASD.</p> <p>The space comprises three main spaces: office space, intervention room and the main room. The main room is 'zoned': learning space, relaxing space and eating space; additional space is provided for staff planning. Toilet facilities, lockers and a kitchen are all included in the area and the outdoor space has been enhanced with benches.</p> <p>An outdoor 'sports sanctuary' is under development.</p> <p>Primarily for students with EHCPs, allocated by County Hall, provision has been made for complex students who are on the EHCP Pathway from within the Trust Secondary Schools.</p> <p>All students are taught a broad and balanced curriculum, including ASDAN (CoPE) and the CREST Award.</p> <p>Students have started to develop the 'Bradgate Garden'.</p>
