Dear Parents and Carers

Planned Strike Action for Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023

It is anticipated that strike action by the National Education Union (NEU) will go ahead on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March, if we are advised otherwise we will let you know immediately. This is the union with the largest staff representation and in preparing for a day of industrial action we have to work on the basis that the majority of those staff who are members, will be out of school on that day.

Our responsibility is to open the school as effectively as possible on that day whilst remaining within the safe level of staffing and also to give enough notice for parents to make preparations for childcare on that day.

Having reviewed the plans from the last Strike Day we have out the following plan in place:

**Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March** – all year 11 students will be in school as normal  
Students from Years 7, 8, 9 & 10 who require childcare will be able to come into school – please request a place through this form.

**Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March** – all Year 10 students will be in school as normal  
Students in Years 7, 8, 9 & 11 who require childcare will be able to come into school - school – please request a place through this form

**School Transport**

School buses will be available as normal. Please indicate on the form on the link above on the relevant day if your child travels by bus and requires transport on the day of the strike.

If your child travels to or from school by taxi provided by the Council/other provider please indicate on the form on the link above on the relevant day, whether you will need that transport for your child on either day of the strike.

**Free School Meals**

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and they are not in school on the 15<sup>th</sup> or 16<sup>th</sup> March, we can provide a packed lunch for them for that day. Please tell us if your child requires a packed lunch by completing the relevant section on the form above. Click on the links above.

Packed lunches will be available to collect at the end of the school day, the day before.
